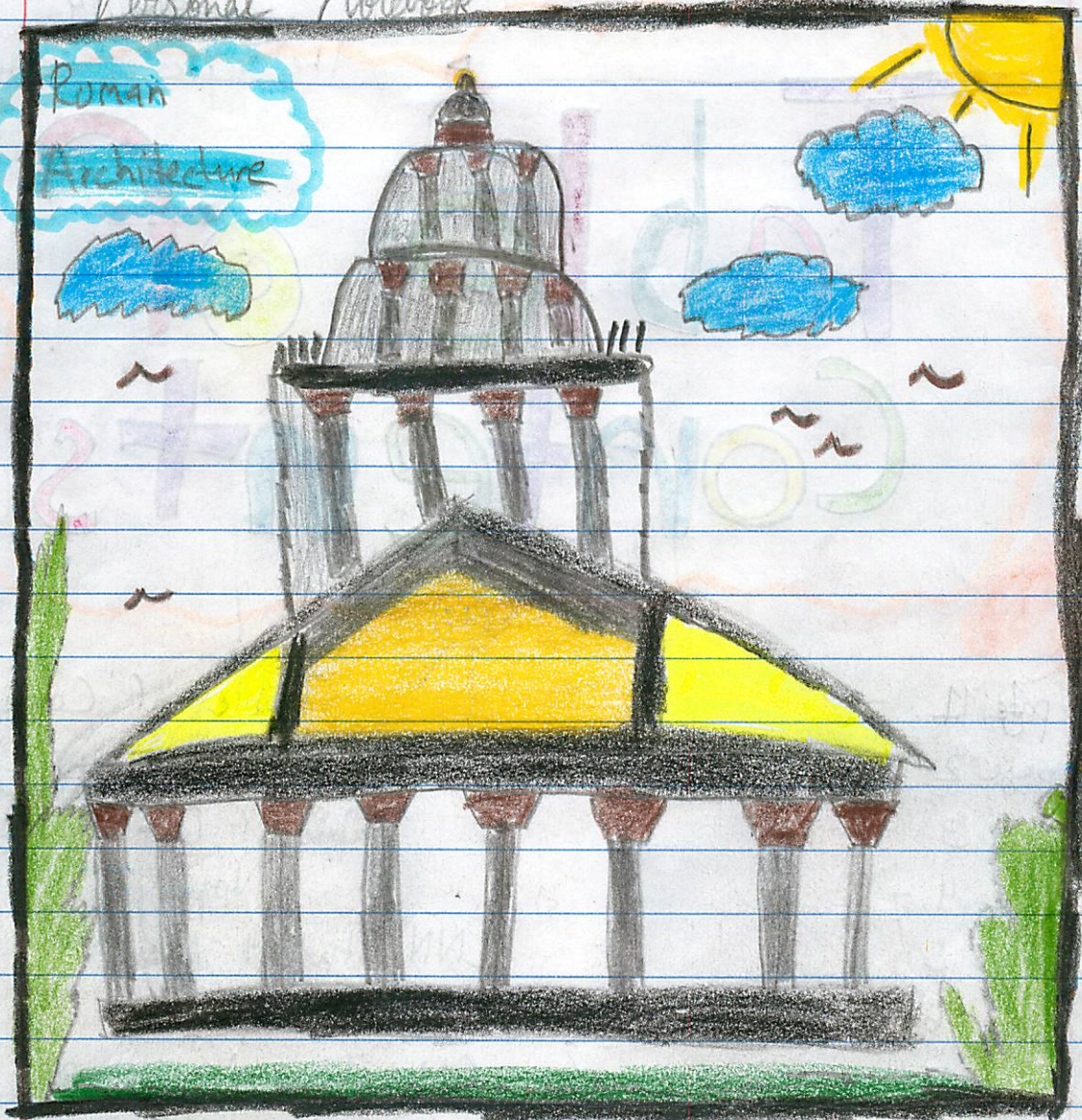

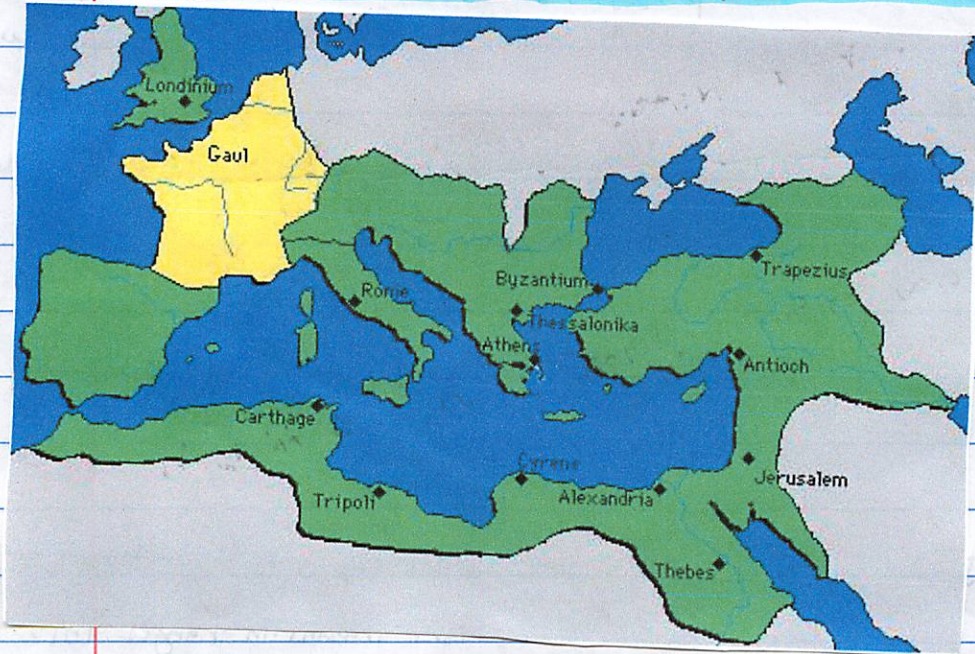

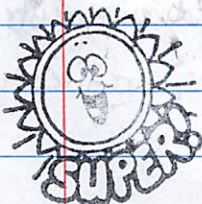
Map #1 The Roman Empire at Its Height, 117

### Fall of the Western Roman Empire

- Dioctetian → Roman emperor, he divided the Roman Empire into two halves.
- Constantine → First Christian Roman emperor, he briefly reunited the two halves of the Roman Empire. He also moved Rome's capital to Constantinople.
- Clodis → Frankish king, he built a huge kingdom in Gaul.
- Attila → Leader of the Huns, he led invasions of Constantinople, Greece, Gaul, and Northern Italy and was greatly feared by the Romans.
- corruption → The decay of people's values.

Summary: The Roman grew too large to protect, and soon many different groups attacked the Empire at once. The barbarians invaded Rome and settled along the northern border. The Huns, led by Attila, and the Goths also attacked the Empire. People fled for safety, and soon, the empire around Rome slowly collapsed.

- Justinian → Emperor of the Eastern Roman Empire, he organized all Roman laws into a legal system called Justinian's Code. He also conquered much of the Mediterranean and built Hagia Sophia.
- Theodora → Empress of the Eastern Roman Empire and Justinian's wife, she helped her husband rule.
- Byzantine Empire → A society that developed in the eastern Roman Empire after the west fell.
- Mosaics → Pictures made with pieces of colored stone or glass.

Summary: Justinian and Theodora ruled the eastern Roman empire, facing many rivals and enemies. The western and eastern empire had different kind of governments, but Christianity was still central to the Byzantines' lives.

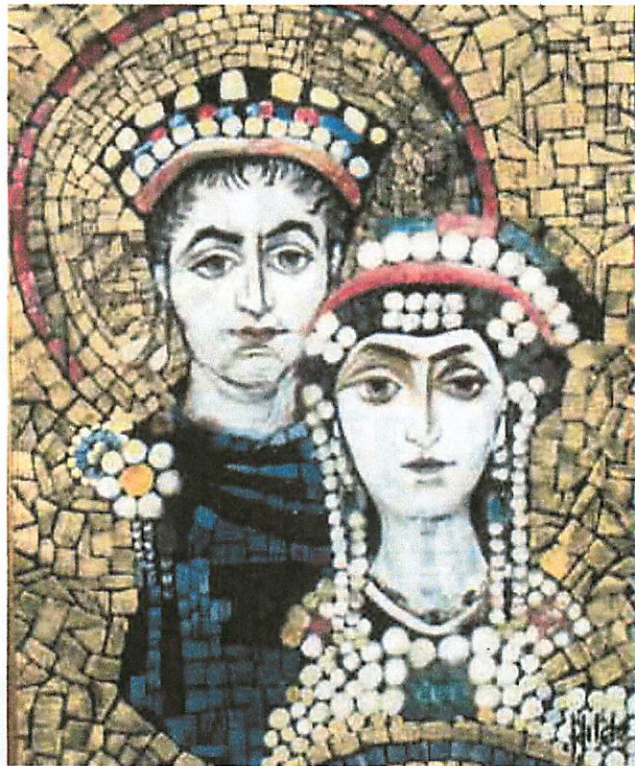
