Vocab: Framers: original writers of the Constitution who "framed" the role of government Questions: "Is there a point where Judicial interpretation is called into question? "What was the last amendment made to the Constitution? Reaction" It's interesting and comforting that the courts have the power to essentially override the government. Connection: Shows that the government is able to "keep up with the times with regard to women's rights Significance" Being able to informally amend the Constitution allows the president and Congress to make legislation to quickly impact the economy	that bends the rules without amending
