

#### Gov. Orval Faubus sends in Nat'l Guard to "keep the peace"






He claimed it was "impossible to integrate some our schools at this time without violence."



The Arkansas National Guard turned the Little Rock Nine away and prevented them from entering the school for three weeks.






On Sept 23, the Nine were escorted by the National Guard and entered through a side entrance of the school.


